

# Holy Ghost

Joel 2:28 And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: ***Prophesied that God will pour out his spirit upon flesh(man)***

Ac 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: ***What's the power for? To overcome sin!***

Acts 2:3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. ***Each one of them speaking with tongues at the same time. Remember this chapter is letting your know through the book of Acts and on that tongue is speaking in an unknown language, like as a fire. Remember Heb 12:29 For our God is a consuming fire. So the unknown tongue comes straight from God.***

Acts 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. ***Filled and speak with other tongues!***

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. ***It's a gift not a person. It's a gift of God's Spirit in your soul.***

Ac 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God. ***Holy Ghost is the spirit of God and Christ, because there was no throne in Heaven, only Jesus standing on the right hand of God!***

Acts 10:45 And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost. Ac 10:46 For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. ***How did they know the Gentiles had the Holy Ghost? Because they heard them speak with tongues.***

Ac 11:16 Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost. ***It's like water it's a submersion in the spirit of God.***

Ac 13:52 And the disciples were filled with joy, and with the Holy Ghost. ***Filled with a spirit of Joy and the Holy Ghost***

Ac 19:2 He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. ***If they believed in Jesus why didn't they have the Holy Ghost? Because it is a gift from God another step in Christ. Jesus even was filled and full of the Holy Ghost. Luke 4:1 And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, Matthew 1:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.***

# Holy Ghost

Acts 19:6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

Heb 6:4 For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, ***It's a gift!***

Heb 2:4 God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost. ***Gifts of the Holy Ghost!***

Heb 10:15 Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: ***for after that he had said It's a witness of God.***

Luke 11:13 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him? ***You ask for the Gift of the Holy Ghost.***

Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, ***It seals you, what does it mean sealed you with the holy spirit? You need to be made alive to God by his spirit. How are you Born again. Jesus said unless you be born again you shall not enter the Kingdom of God. The Holy Ghost is a sealing of a new birth in Christ through the spirit of God. 2Co 1:22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.***

Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. ***Holy Spirit is of God. Not its own person. It's to keep you until that day of redemption.***

1Thess 4:8 He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us his holy Spirit. ***God gave us his Holy Spirit (Gift)***

1Co 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? ***It's in you and of God!***

1Co 12:10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: ***gifts is Holy Ghost with tongues***

1Co 12:28 And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. {diversities: or, kinds} ***gifts is Holy Ghost with tongues***

1Co 12:30 Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret?

1Co 13:1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

1Co 13:8 Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away. {fail: Gr. vanish away}

1Co 14:2 For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries

1Co 14:4 He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church. ***Paul was letting them know that this is connection between you and God and a personal connection.***

1Co 14:5 I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater is he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying. ***Letting them know speaking in tongues is important but prophesying in tongues is even a greater thing not common as they were allowing it.***

1Co 14:6 Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or by doctrine? ***Telling them if the spirit is not giving interpretation then they just walk up and speak in tongues to someone.***

1Co 14:13 Wherefore let him that speaketh in an unknown tongue pray that he may interpret. ***If you get up in church and just speak in tongues, let there be an interpreter.***

1Co 14:14 For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful. ***Many times we don't know what we are praying because our Holy Ghost within us is praying to the Lord.***

1Co 14:27 If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret. ***Again, If you get up in church and just speak in tongues, let there be an interpreter.***

1Co 14:18 I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than ye all: 1 Co 14:19 Yet in the church I had rather speak five words with my understanding, that by my voice I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an unknown tongue. ***Paul saying he speaks in tongues more than they all do. But it was not meant for teaching in the church but edifying.***

1Co 14:22 Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that believe, but to them that believe not: but prophesying serveth not for them that believe not, but for them which believe. ***Speaking in tongues to people that don't believe is not going to get you anywhere.***

1Co 14:23 If therefore the whole church be come together into one place, and all speak with tongues, and there come in those that are unlearned, or unbelievers, will they not say that ye are

mad? *If the whole church service all you do is set and talk in tongues then your not going to convert anyone.*

1Co 14:39 Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues. *With all of this do not stop anyone from speaking in tongues.*

1Thess 1:6 And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost: *The Holy Ghost is that eternal Joy and Power of God.*

2Timothy 1:14 That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us. *It's the spirit of God in us!*

Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost. *It's a birth a renewing of our life.*

1John 5:7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. *The Holy Ghost and his word are one. When Jesus said, John 17:22 And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: They are one, in spirit, word and truth. That spirit is the Holy Ghost. Eph 4:4 There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; Eph 4:5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism, Eph 4:6 One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.*
