

## Daily Finding the Will of God

JAM 4:13-15

God has a will for each of us daily. It consists of things that are expected from us every day. If we are daily seeking to do His will, we will be in a much better place to respond if He should communicate some *specific* direction to us.

Look what happened to Ananias:

ACT 9:10-12

If Ananias had not been watching to please God in his daily activities, he might not have been sensitive enough to hear God's *specific instructions*. Because Ananias was receptive and obedient to God, God used him to heal the Apostle Paul!

1 TH 4:3

JAM 4:8

1 JO 3:3

LUK 18:1

### ***A daily load of benefits and gifts to work with:***

Jesus has received some gifts from God - some things to benefit us daily. Even rebellious individuals can "cash in" on some of these benefits, as well as the non-rebellious, because these particular benefits are motivated by God's desire is TO DWELL WITH US!

If God doesn't get down where we are living today, we will NEVER get to where He is living. His rain, both natural and spiritual, is one such benefit or gift to us.

Let us follow David's example and not be afraid to take the cup of God's salvation DAILY that He offers to us and be bold to call upon His name!

### ***A daily care and ministering to others:***

2 CO 11:28

Some will say that the daily care of all the churches was the apostle Paul's job alone. It certainly was his daily care, but it must have been an outgrowth of the following kind of care:

JAM 2:15,16

ACT 6:1

This DAILY CARE FOR OTHERS is not to be only natural food and clothing. There are other daily needs in which we need to consider one another:

HEB 3:13

JOH 5:12

MAT 25:40

*DAILY CARE OF OTHERS is very important to the Lord!*

### ***A daily renewal of the inner man to experience:***

2 CO 4:16-18

Our "inward man" is that part of us which is born of God and becomes a member part of that "NEW MAN," Jesus Christ.

Our "outward man" is that part of us which was born of Adam and was once a functioning member or part of the "OLD MAN," Adam. If we try to live and function in this part of ourselves, we are under a "dead head." Adam, himself, perished and that perishing continues through all his offspring which are just his extended parts. These parts have no part in the renewal of the inward man.

1 CO 15:22

This DAILY RENEWAL of the inner man is part of the process of being made alive. It is a resurrection - not a natural one, but a spiritual one. This renewal comes to us through two main ways, through the SPIRIT and through the TRUTH:

EPH 4:23,24

COL 3:10

Jesus, who is the express image of the invisible God, HAD HIS OWN DAILY WALK WITH GOD. He picked up his daily cross long before he hung on the literal cross. When Jesus went to the literal cross, he has already crucified his fleshly nature with its affections and lusts. He used the nails that he had received from the Only Wise God, his Father. Did you see Jesus' nailing down his fleshly nature in Luke 4:3-12?

Jesus also had DAILY BREAD from God:

JOH 4:31-34

JOH 6:57

Even BEFORE Jesus came down from heaven to be born in the manger, he had a DAILY RELATIONSHIP with his Father:

**Pro. 8:30 Then I was by him, [as] one brought up [with him]: and I was daily [his] delight, rejoicing always before him.**
