## PHYSICAL DEATH

## ETERNAL JUDGMENT - OVERVIEW

God, who is eternal, has ALREADY set judgments for mankind. These are eternal judgments in three categories.

The FIRST CATEGORY: RIGHTEOUS or JUST $=$ the majority of believers who have not completely overcome, but are found RIGHTEOUS or JUST in the final judgment: They must finish overcoming in the new earth.
LUK 14:14
MAT 10:22
MAT 5:5
Those who finish overcoming in this life, are really not a separate category of judgment, because those saints who overcome, COMPLETE their judgment under the RIGHTEOUS or JUST category and become ONE WITH THE JUDGE.

They will be JUDGING in the throne with Jesus, because they were the FIRSTFRUITS, or the first of the Righteous/Just to mature into Christ:

## ETERNAL JUDGMENT OF THE

## RIGHTEOUS

The words "RIGHTEOUS" and "JUST" in the New Testament mean exactly the same thing. Both come from one Greek word, $\boldsymbol{\delta} \boldsymbol{1} \boldsymbol{\alpha} \boldsymbol{1 0} \boldsymbol{\sigma}$ (dikaios) meaning: "conformed to right, or law". (Strong's word \# 1342)

Both words in the Old Testament also come from one Hebrew word, qydu (tzaddeek) meaning: "just, lawful, righteous". (Strong's word \# 6662)

HOWEVER, there are TWO KINDS of righteousness:
ONE, the product of the law, which never produced the righteousness of God:

## ETERNAL JUDGMENT OF THE SINNER

In the New Testament, the word "sinner" comes from the Greek word, $\alpha \mu \alpha \rho \tau \omega \lambda \sigma \sigma$ (ham-ar-to-los') meaning:
"UN-MARKer, or one who misses the mark". (Strong's word \# 268)

In the Old Testament, the word "sinner" comes from,
ajh (khaw-taw') meaning: "misser, faulter, offender, sinner, tresspasser". (Strong's word \# 2398)

A SINNER is one who knows to do good and aims, but misses the mark:

## ETERNAL JUDGMENT OF THE UNGODLY

The Greek word is, " $\alpha \sigma \varepsilon \beta \eta \varsigma^{\prime \prime}$ (as-eb-ace') meaning UN-REVERer, irreverence, one who does not revere. (Strong's word \#765).

The Hebrew word is, esr (raw-shaw') meaning one who is ungodly or wicked in their ways, not respecting God. (Strong's word \#7563)

The UNGODLY-WICKED is the term used to identify
general humanity which is all of Adam's natural descendents that have not believed the words of the only true God. They abide in the spiritual death that Adam passed on to them.
